



EGYPT VISA APPLICATION INFORMATION



Important Notice

- **Egypt** must be your **main destination**
- You must be **resident in the UK**. This means that you have to be in possession of one of the following visas:
 - Holiday Working Visa
 - Ancestry Visa
 - Work Permit/Highly Skilled Migrant Visa
 - Spousal Visa
 - Any other visa or passport that qualifies you as a resident in the UK

NB. We cannot help you if you have a tourist / fiancé visa

The visa currently takes 3 days to get from the Embassy and we need your documents at least 1 week before we lodge it.

What documents do you need to apply?

In addition to UK and EU nationals, citizens of the following countries do not require a visa before travel. Visas can be obtained upon arrival at any of the Egyptian ports of entry: **Canada, Croatia, Georgia, Japan, Norway, Macedonia, Republic of Korea, Russian Federation, Serbia, Ukraine and USA.**

- One (1) completed visa application form (remember to sign it).
- Two (2) colour passport photos.
- Your passport
- Students have to show proof of Enrolment at the University or College, document can not be older than one month.

For The following nationalities and holders of Travel Documents, visa APPROVAL MUST BE SOUGHT from the competent Authorities in Egypt, and can take up to 6 weeks to obtain: **Iran, Tunisia, Somalia, Morocco, Algeria, Lebanon, Iraq, Palestine, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Sudan, Djibouti, Mauritania, Comoros, Burundi, Rwanda, Liberia, Nigeria, Ghana, Sierra Leone, Mali, Niger, Chad, Israel, Afghanistan, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Moldova, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Indonesia, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Myanmar.**

NB: If the applicant is married to a British National and travelling with their spouse they will not be required to approval from Egypt.

Approval/rejection of application takes approximately six weeks and the applicant is advised to contact the Consulate via email/telephone (stating the date of application/full name/nationality) so that the consulate may inform him of the decision taken regarding his application require approval from the competent Authorities in Egypt prior to issuing the visa (this process takes 6 to 8 weeks). Kindly note that original documents and fees are NOT required until approval has been obtained.

* Your passport must have at least one blank page to issue your visa on. If you want us to post your passport back to you, please make sure that you include a page with the correct address to

which we need to return your passport to. An extra cost of £6 must be included as postage fee.
We need to receive your documents a WEEK in advance before applying for your visa to ensure that you meet all the requirements.
